Dear American Friends of Game and Wildlife Conservation:

For those of you that enjoy shooting in the UK, the presence of your quarry in large numbers is because of the work of the GWCT. Nationally, wild grey partridge numbers are increasing, but only where our advisors have made recommendations to improve management or where our guidelines for management have been fully taken up. The work of our advisors and those that can influence land use policy continues and requires ongoing (and increasing) levels of funding.

Traditionally, GCUSA has supported the GWCT's work on wild grey partridges. As you may already know, we successfully took a remnant population of grey partridges at Royston (less than three pairs per square kilometre) and five years later produced 18 pairs per km2 proving that population recovery was possible.

Our current demonstration project at the Rotherfield Estate poses an even more daunting and higher stakes challenge to the restoration of the wild grey partridge population. The Estate has fewer birds and much less favorable habitats for wild game, but if we are as successful here, many more landowners will be convinced of our restoration credentials.

The reared pheasant also features prominently among current GWCT research projects. Working in collaboration with scientists from Exeter University, we are studying why released birds that survive the shooting season and the winter are poor at producing their own young the following season. Our work here has as its objective the improvement of the breeding success of surviving birds.

GCUSA's fundraising activities on behalf of the GWCT helps maintain the UK countryside as a place you would want to visit. On behalf of the Trust and its scientific team, and on the occasion of GCUSA's 25th anniversary, I would like to warmly thank you for your continued and critical support.

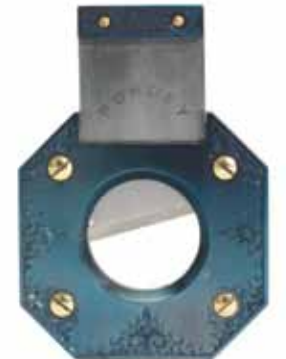

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Will I need to bring to my gun? For most shooting excursions to the UK, you will need to bring your own gun. A permit for each gun is required, which can be arranged through the Game & Wildlife Conservation Trust (GWCT). For certain shooting locales near London, guns can be rented.

Are these shoots commercially available? These shoots are private and normally unobtainable on the open market.

What expenses are not included in the trip price? The following expenses are not included: Transportation to the shooting destination, tipping, (typically £100/Day), and cartridges.

What transportation is provided? If the shoot involves travel to more than one location, the host will make the local travel arrangements.

Are spouses allowed on the shoot? Yes, spouses may accompany the shooter on the peg.

Are there activities for non-shooting spouses? This will depend on location, but usually trips to nearby metropolitan centers for sightseeing and/or shopping can be arranged.

Are the dates of the shooting trips flexible? As these events take place on private estates, the shooting dates are firm.

Payment terms: Payment for auction items is expected within 10 days of the conclusion of the auction.

What part of the purchase price is tax-deductible? Contributions above the fair market value of the lots can be considered a tax-deductible contribution to the GCUSA. Fair market value is generally determined based on a seasonal “cost per bird.”

Is there VAT tax assessed on the purchase price? No. UK excursions purchased at auction through the GCUSA/GWCT are not subject to the 20% VAT tax.

Are these trips subject to any letting or agent fees? No, unlike most driven shoots taken in the UK, these are not subject to a 10-15% “letting” fee.
